

Investment Objective

The objective of the Fund is to preserve capital, maintain liquidity and generate current income by investing in high quality short-term fixed income or adjustable rate securities denominated in the base currency of the Fund.

The Fund is a Short Term Low-Volatility Net Asset Value (LVNAV) Money Market Fund as defined by the EU Money Market Funds Regulations. LVNAV funds are valued using a mixture of the amortised cost and market pricing to facilitate a stable NAV. However in certain circumstances LVNAV funds may be priced with a variable NAV. The Fund invests in high quality short-term government and corporate bonds as well as cash deposits and debt instruments issued by financial institutions.

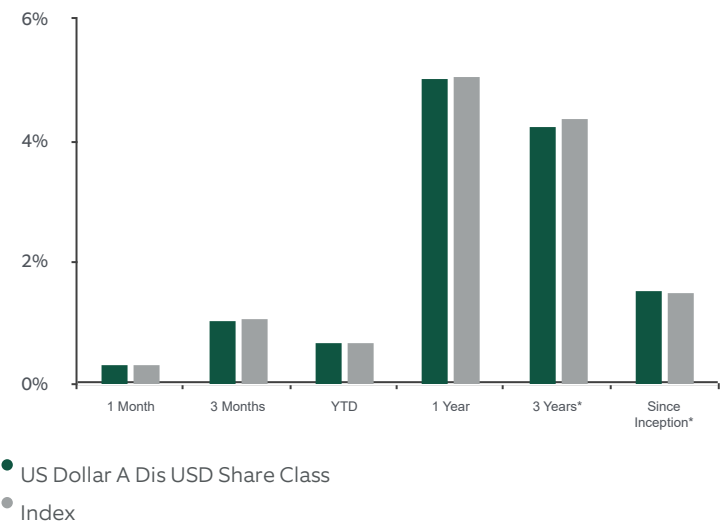
All securities in which the Fund invests will be denominated in US Dollars and at the time of purchase have a minimum credit rating of A2/P1 by Moody's credit rating agency or an equivalent rating from another agency and will have a maximum maturity of 397 days.

The Fund may enter into repurchase and reverse repurchase agreements to achieve its objective and to reduce risk, minimise costs or generate additional capital or income.

The Fund takes a flexible approach, investing across different bond markets and currencies to take advantage of specific investment opportunities. The fund has the freedom to adjust the fund's sensitivity to interest rate movements, bond exposures and currency exposures.

Target Market: This fund is appropriate for Investors who are looking for an actively managed investment and who plan to invest over a short to medium term.

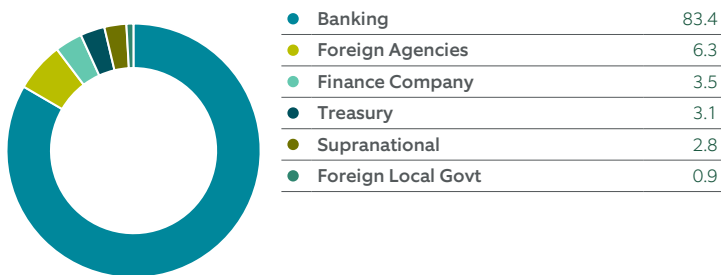

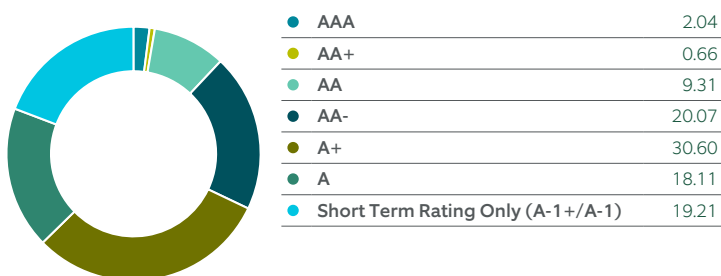

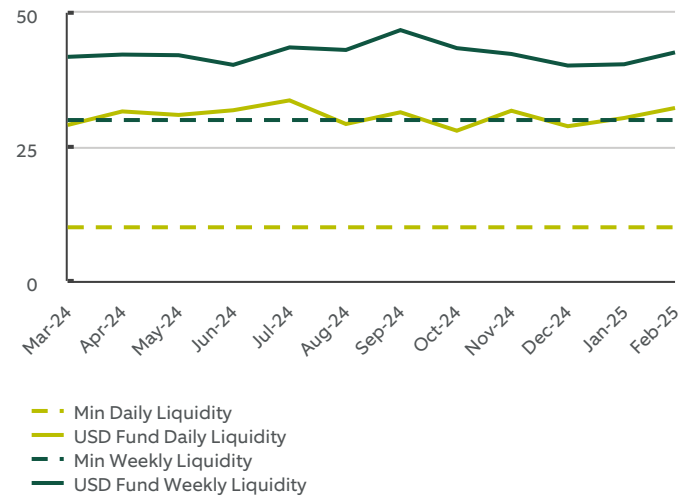
## SECTOR BREAKDOWN (%)



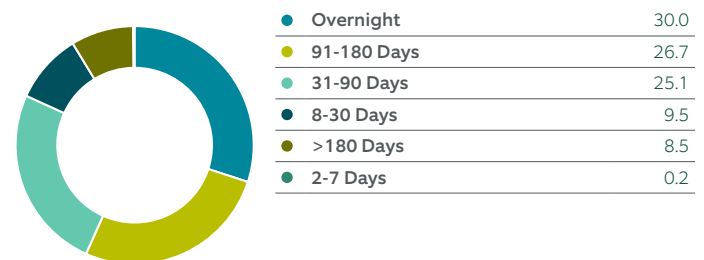
## CREDIT BREAKDOWN (%)



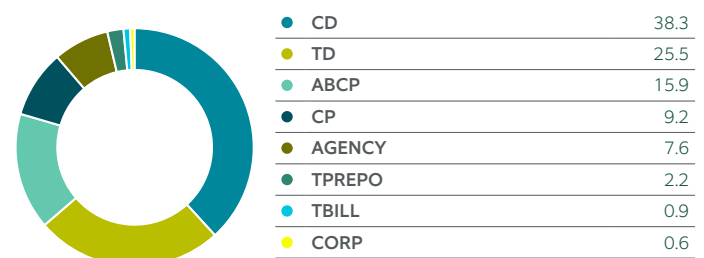
## DAILY &amp; WEEKLY LIQUIDITY PROFILE %



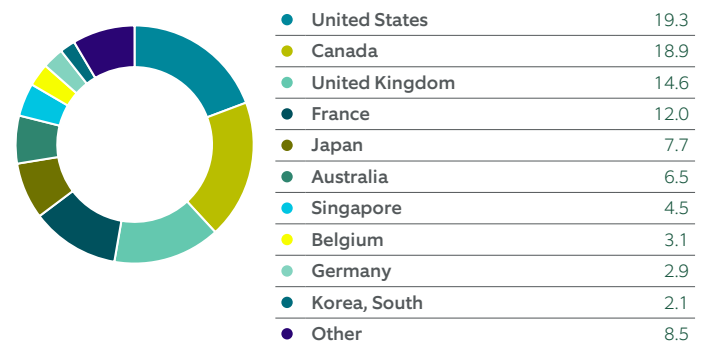
## MATURITY BREAKDOWN (%)

GLOSSARY

ISIN: International Securities Identification Number. It is a 12-digit alphanumeric code that uniquely identifies a specific security.

LT / ST: Long Term / Short Term.

Ongoing Charge: is a figure representing all annual charges and other payments taken from the fund.

Standard Risk Indicator: is a value based on the volatility of the fund, which gives an indication of the overall risk and reward profile of the fund.

WAL (Nominal Weighted Average Life): A bond's maturity is the length of time until the principal amount of the bond is to be repaid. WAL of the fund is calculated as the average of the underlying bonds' maturities, adjusted to take account of their relative weight (size) within the fund.

WAM (Weighted Average Maturity): A bond's maturity is the length of time until the principal amount of the bond is to be repaid. WAM of the ETF is calculated as the average of the underlying bonds' maturities, adjusted to take account of their relative weight (size) within the fund.

Yield to Maturity (%): is the total return anticipated on a bond if the bond is held until it matures.
