FUND OBJECTIVE

The fund seeks to outperform the benchmark before fees over a market cycle (typically 3 years) by investing in a diversified mix of Euro-denominated fixed and floating rate debt securities. There is no guarantee that the investment objective will be achieved and capital invested is at risk. Under normal market conditions, the investment manager will seek to invest at least two-thirds of the fund's Net Asset Value ("NAV") in a diversified portfolio of Euro-denominated debt securities of varying maturities. The fund applies Environmental, Social and Governance ("ESG") criteria in the selection of securities, although it is not the primary consideration for selection.

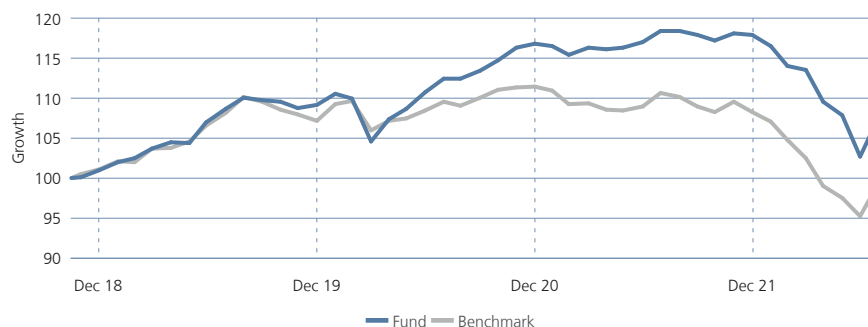

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RISK CONSIDERATIONS

Market Risk: The risk of a change in the value of a position as a result of underlying market factors, including among other things, the overall performance of companies and the market perception of the global economy.
